




Buddy System

- Working in pairs (more experienced + newcomer)




Buddies (what they do)

- Organizing events




History

- ▶ 2009/2010 full training program, 4 ECTS




Number of Buddies






Buddy To-Do List (1)

- Registration to the courses, student card, study information system, library




Buddy To-Do List (2)

- Events for the international students




Training Program (1)




Challenges and Future Plans

- System of buddies is really helpful, it was really necessary at the beginning.




Feedback from International Students (2)




Feedback from International Students (3)


- I just talked with my buddy after arrival once and that's it.
