





- Joint Polish & German degree created by BTU (originaly by the Hochschule Lausitz) and the University of Applied Sciences in Nysa
- Two diplomas Polish & German
- First steps thanks to the Socrates /Erasmus Programme 2006
- ❖ Second step Double Diploma 2007
- ❖ First mobility 2008
- First graduated students 2011
- Till now: over 35 students took or taking part in the programme & over 15 graduates students
